BCCHS Wins 5A & All-Class Awards

BCCHS is the 2010-11 Class 5A All-Sports and All-Class Champion. Carroll scored a record 102.5 points in the school year to unseat the three-time defending Class 5A and All-Class Champion St. Thomas Aquinas by 11 points. Blue Valley Stilwell was third with 69 points. The Golden Eagles started the school year off by sending a team to state in every sport. Cross country netted the first two of four titles with both boys and girls taking home Class 5A team titles. Football was State runner-up. Girls golf tied for second at State with Hays, and boys swimming finished second. Boys bowling placed second at State and the girls third. The girls track and softball teams won Class 5A titles, and the boys track finished second as golf finished third at State.

BC athletic director Larry Dostert does not preach winning as the only goal the Carroll athletes and coaches should focus on. "I try to tell our coaches that winning is a product of doing things right. That they should not be caught up in winning, they should be caught up in developing the athletes to be good responsible citizens."

If you are over the age of 70 ½, you must take a required minimum distribution from your IRA. Normally this distribution is taxed as ordinary income, but from now through the end of 2011, you can roll over up to \$100,000 from your IRA to a qualified charity tax-free. For married couples, each spouse can make a distribution from his or her IRA without penalty. Bishop Carroll Catholic High School is such a charity. "I am excited to begin my new apostolate," she said. "I will very much miss teaching my students, but I am eager to begin serving the church in a new way. God is truly full of surprises!"

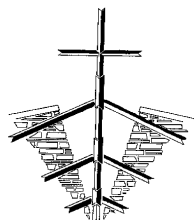

Building The Tradition Update

Several donors have completed their pledges to the *Building The Tradition* Capital Campaign, which we kicked off in 2008. In fact, 550 of the 954 who pledged to the Activities Complex addition are paid in full. Of the \$10,984 thousand pledged, some \$9,945 thousand have been received by the school, and we are closing in on paying off our loan with the diocese.

Eight patrons have given to *Building The Tradition*—Phase II which includes the renovation and expansion of the fine arts facilities, including a new auditorium. We hope to start on this portion of BTT after the bishop's *Together* Campaign is complete.

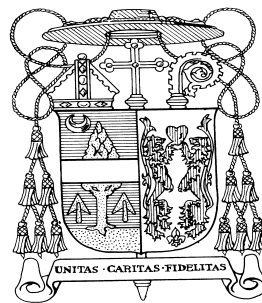
